- 5. Pray that you can trust God more in the week ahead.

Sept 29th – RAINBOW PROMISE

- 1. Read Gen 8:20-9:17.
- 2. Grab some colouring pencils and paper, or some materials for getting arty.
- 3. Make a rainbow and ark scene together as a family.
- 4. Pray and thank God for the new start that he gave his people.
- 5. Thank God for Jesus who gave us a new start and helps us to know God.
